Our planned AI program was delayed recently due to a great opportunity of purchasing semen and rights to a very highly classified double polled red bull from Tasmania. Four of our best cows went for AI ET with Elmwood Robson semen.

Having now put on hold using the newly acquired semen we concentrated our efforts on using Elmwood Robson.

We are pleased to announce we have 40 quality embryos from the AI ET harvest and look forward to offering some of these offspring in the coming few years.

New venture for Darlingrange Dexters

After some detailed research we have embarked on a natural method of reducing intestinal parasites, we have extended our operation to include Boar Goats.

Boar Goats compliment Dexters in every way being easy care and naturally friendly and along with their hardiness they are great producers of Kids, quick growing and meaty.

They help reduce the cycle of gut parasites by companion grazing on paddocks that cattle have first been in then running the goats and finally spelling the paddock, as a goat eats less fussily it cleans up what the cattle have neglected reducing the residual burden of parasites in your pasture.

The new pasture is in; we have great expectations from our new selection with historical evidence that it will not only increase yield but also palatability and protein in the feed.

A permanent strand of Lucerne has been sown to boost steer growth and increase our beef marbling. It is expected that the 30 acres combined with Oats will yield 100 rolls with a second cut planned for late December of pure Lucerne.

We have been advised that we should expect 1 roll per acre or around .75 of a Ton. This will enable us to finish our steers and weather goats on prime feed.

Our remaining 50 acres we have sown Popney vetch and barley for a high protein bulk feed. Expectations are that will yield 7 ton of grain and 250 rolls of top class hay.

Leaving the stubble to mulch into the soil increasing fertility through carbon and water retention.
